



SANITARY PAD DISTRIBUTION

In 2024, the Save Tears Foundation took a bold step toward women's empowerment by distributing **1,157** sanitary napkins to underserved communities across Mumbai. This initiative aimed to improve menstrual hygiene, raise awareness, and break the stigma surrounding menstruation.






